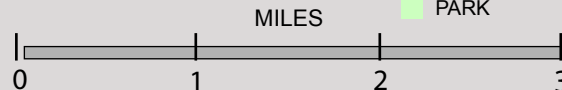

The paved bike route along 107th Engineers Memorial Highway sometimes has a paved shoulder for a portion of it, ending at the Union Bay Campground; otherwise, you need to share the road and ride on the outside of the vehicle lane to the Lake of the Clouds area. Between Silver City and South Boundary Road, the bike route is fairly flat, but once you get to the west of South Boundary Road, you will begin to encounter several steep, tall hills.

The trails in the park are mostly dirt/grass.

From Silver City, it is 3 miles to the state park and 8 miles to Lake of the Clouds.
